Getting to the event and getting home

MightyStriders

Public Transport to Holyrood Park

Some public transport is available on Sunday morning from the city centre to Holyrood Park. Check the Lothian Buses website for up to date information and schedules – <u>https://www.lothianbuses.com/</u>

There are limited train services on a Sunday morning. Please check <u>www.travelinescotland.com</u> before travelling.

Some public transport is available from Scottish Gas Murrayfield back to the city centre. Check the Edinburgh tram website for more information – <u>https://edinburghtrams.com/</u>

No Parking at Holyrood Park

There is no parking available at Holyrood Park. Please arrange to be dropped off or use the Kiltwalk bus to get to your start line.

Morning Kiltwalk Buses for Mighty Striders

Kiltwalk bus service costs £7.50pp and is available to <u>book here</u>.

The Mighty Stride Kiltwalk bus departs from Scottish Gas Murrayfield stadium (EH12 5PJ) where there is some parking available.The journey takes around 20 minutes to the start site.

As there is no parking available in and around Holyrood Park, there is no Afternoon/Evening Kiltwalk available to book.

We advise that Mighty Striders use Public Transport to return to Holyrood Park or arrange to be picked up from Roseburn Street outside Scottish Gas Murrayfield. If you are a wheelchair user and would like to book a space on the bus, please email us at <u>contactus@thekiltwalk.co.uk</u> and we will do our very best to accommodate your needs.

Unfortunately dogs are not allowed on board, with the exception of service dogs. We apologise for any inconvenience.

Parking at Fisherrow Links, Musselburgh

No parking is available for walkers around this start site. Free parking will be available in Musselburgh Racecourse Car Parks 1 & 2 (Balcarres Road, EH21 7SB) which is a short 10 minute walk from the Big Stroll start line. The bookable Kiltwalk bus will take walkers back to the racecourse parking after the walk is completed.

Kiltwalk bus service costs £7.50pp and is available to book here.

The evening service picks up from the Kiltwalk Village at Scottish Gas Murrayfield Stadium (EH12 5PJ) and drops back at Musselburgh Racecourse where there is plenty of parking available at Car Park 1 & 2.

WeeWanderers

The Wee Wander has a brand new start site at Victoria Park (EH6 4PZ). Please approach the start race arch just off Newhaven Road avoiding our Pit Stop set up which is just off Craighall Road.

Public Transport to Victoria Park

Some public transport is available from Edinburgh City Centre to Victoria Park.

Free Shuttle bus to Victoria Park

Parking in and around Victoria Park is extremely limited so Kiltwalk has arranged a free-to-use shuttle service that will operate between Forth Ports, Leith and Victoria Park where the Wee Wander starts.

This allows Wee Wander participants to park free of charge at Forth Ports, Melrose Dr, Leith, Edinburgh EH6 6NH and use the free shuttle service to get to the Wee Wander start line at Victoria Park, 141 Newhaven Rd, Edinburgh EH6 4PZ.



No Parking at Victoria Park

Parking in and around Victoria Park is extremely limited we therefore recommend getting dropped off, utilising our free shuttle service from Forth Ports or using the Kiltwalk bookable bus service from Scottish Gas Murrayfield.
